Our support for you

Following the statement by the Government and the increased risk of infection from Covid-19 we are taking the following action:

- All face to face contact will be suspended with immediate effect. This includes tuition, Development Manager meetings, group activities, and home visits.
- YCDT and Development Managers will be in contact on a very regular basis weekly via phone and internet calls.
- We have set up a series of regular skype group meetings for all YCDT young carers to join in and provide peer support for each other.
- We are setting up a series of webinars for all young carers in any location, more information to follow.
- YCDT is open as normal 9am -5.30pm Monday to Friday and will be available to support you.
